## LAURENTH

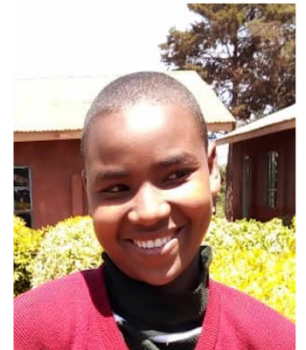
